Sir.

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say that the Governor of Assam is pleased to accord Revised Administrative Approval as accorded by Govt. of India for an amount of Rs.1460.65 Lakh (Rupees Fourteen Crore Sixty Lakh Sixty Five Thousand only) for implementation of the project - "Construction of Roads in Tinsukia Town", Assam under Non Lapsable Central Pool of Resources (NLCPR) for the year 2017-18 subject to the following terms and conditions:

- Out of the total amount of Rs.1460.65 Lakh (Rupees Fourteen Crore Sixty Lakh Sixty Five Thousand only), Rs. 1314.58 Lakh (Rupees Thirteen Crore Fourteen Lakh Fifty Eight Thousand only) being the 90% will be borne by Govt. of India and the balance 10% i.e. Rs.146.07 Lakh (Rupees One Crore Forty Six Lakh Seven Thousand only) will be borne by the State Government from its own resources.
- 2. The implementing agency will comply with observations made by M/S. WAPCOS Ltd. The implementing agency will ensure non duplicity of roads under construction in the projects (1) Construction of Roads at Tinsukia Town (2) Improvement of Roads of Tinsukia Master Plan Area, Tinsukia and (3) Tinsukia Town Water Supply Scheme Phase I & Phase II.
- The Implementing Agency should follow all codal formalities and strictly adhere to the project implementation schedule and physical targets as per DPR.
- Project implementation by the implementing agency shall be governed by rules, conditions, stipulated in revised guidelines of NLCPR.
- The time frame for completion of the project is 24 months from the date of issue of Administrative Approval. The time framed should be followed strictly.
- 6. The implementing agency will firm up quarterly physical and financial targets keeping in view, target date and convey the same to the Ministry of DONER within one month immediately on receipt of the Administrative Approval. Thereafter, quarterly report of physical and financial progress of the project should be furnished to the Ministry of DONER within 2 weeks of close of quarter.
- 7. The project shall be implemented strictly in time and with the help of PERT/ CPM which is to be submitted to the Department with copy of the work order which is to be strictly adhered to subsequently.
- The funds shall be utilized within specified time and strictly for the purpose for which it is being sanctioned. No diversion of fund is allowed.
- 9. Any escalation towards costs of the project has to be borne by the Implementing Agency from their

The Finance Department / Transformation & Development Department shall ensure transmission of released amount to the Department concerned within 15 days from date of release by Govt. of India and submit certificate in this behalf within prescribed time limit to Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region.
- 11. The implementing agency will properly utilized funds and submit utilization certificate in prescribed proforma to this Department for onward submission to Transformation & Development Department within 12 months from the date of release. In case, funds are not utilized within the stipulated time, the Transformation & Development Department should approach the Ministry of DONER for revalidation with sound reasoning.
- 12. The implementing agency will ensure submission of quarterly progress report as per progress of work executed based on PERT.
- 13. The implementing agency shall get the project inspected on ground at least once in a quarter and submit physical progress report in prescribed proforma within 2 (two) weeks to the Govt. for onward submission to the Ministry of DONER.
- 14. The Nodal Officer for the project is Director, Town & Country Planning, Assam.
- 15. The implementing agency for the project is Tinsukia Municipal Board, Tinsukia.
