The involvement of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) would be subject to the approval of the National Legal Services Authority which is the apex body under the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 by an appropriate Administrative Order.

They will convene bi-monthly meeting and submit progress / status report to the Government in Urban Development Department.


